DISABLED VETERAN WISH PROGRAM

This program is available for Indiana Military Resident recipients, with limited resources, who are unable to accomplish a wish for themselves. To request a Wish, a potential recipient should review the WISH Granting Guidelines below.

A WISH DOES NOT HAVE TO INCLUDE TRAVEL!

A WISH could include a shopping trip, day at the spa, meet a celebrity, night out on the town, holiday help, assistance with mobility, and / or an activity or stay within the USA. It is Your WISH, You Make it.

If you WISH it, we will do our best to make it come true!

ELIGIBILITY

Indiana adults, age 18 years and older, who have served in the United States Military and have been classified by the United States Military (DD214) as disabled and / or have developed a Terminal Illness (Based on a Doctors Statement as to health condition).

WISH GRANTING GUIDELINES

Listed below are the following restrictions, limitations, and guidelines that apply.

- Recipient must be a Military Veteran, classified by the United States Military as Disabled (DDFORM 214), or who has developed a terminal illness since leaving the Military – We define adult as someone 18 years of age and over. We define terminal as someone with less than one year to live. The recipient's treating physician must sign a medical form verifying the health of the recipient.
- The WISH must be the WISH of the recipient – Recipient must be able to communicate and comprehend the WISH experience.
- Participants in the WISH must be the immediate family of the recipient – We define immediate family as spouse or significant other, children under the age of 18 living in same household, or father, mother, and siblings under the age of 18 living in the same household.
- The WISH must not be a surprise – We do not want to risk violating the privacy of the recipient.



- The WISH must be legal – The WISH must not violate any laws.
- The WISH must be safe - The nature of the WISH must not present any danger to the WISH recipient or any sponsored participants. This includes a travel WISH that may be detrimental to one's health.
- The WISH must take place in the United States – The WISH must take place in the United States and cannot include requests for visas or cruises.
- The Disabled Veterans Wish Foundation may require a Criminal Background check. If applicant has ever had a Felony Conviction, please do not apply.

The DISABLED VETERAN WISH FOUNDATION **CANNOT** grant the following types of requests:

- For cash, RV rentals, real estate, or property,
- To provide legal assistance or medical treatments
- For assistance to pay bills (including medical expenses)
- For visas, cruises, or travel outside of the U.S.
- For those who are not residents of Indiana

All WISH Recipients are encouraged to make realistic choices. Please make choices that will fulfill a WISH from the heart. All WISHES are subject to approval by The Disabled Veteran Wish Foundation.
